#### ACT Test Dates

BYU and many other universities use a student's highest ACT score to determine admission and scholarship decisions no matter how many times the student took the test. Therefore, it may be advantageous for some students to take the ACT multiple times.

Registration and fees must be submitted online at ACT.org. If you are interested in taking the ACT this year, please make note of these Saturday test dates and registration deadlines:
