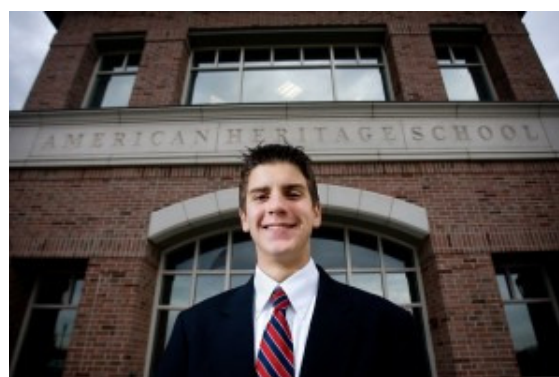


In Middle School:
