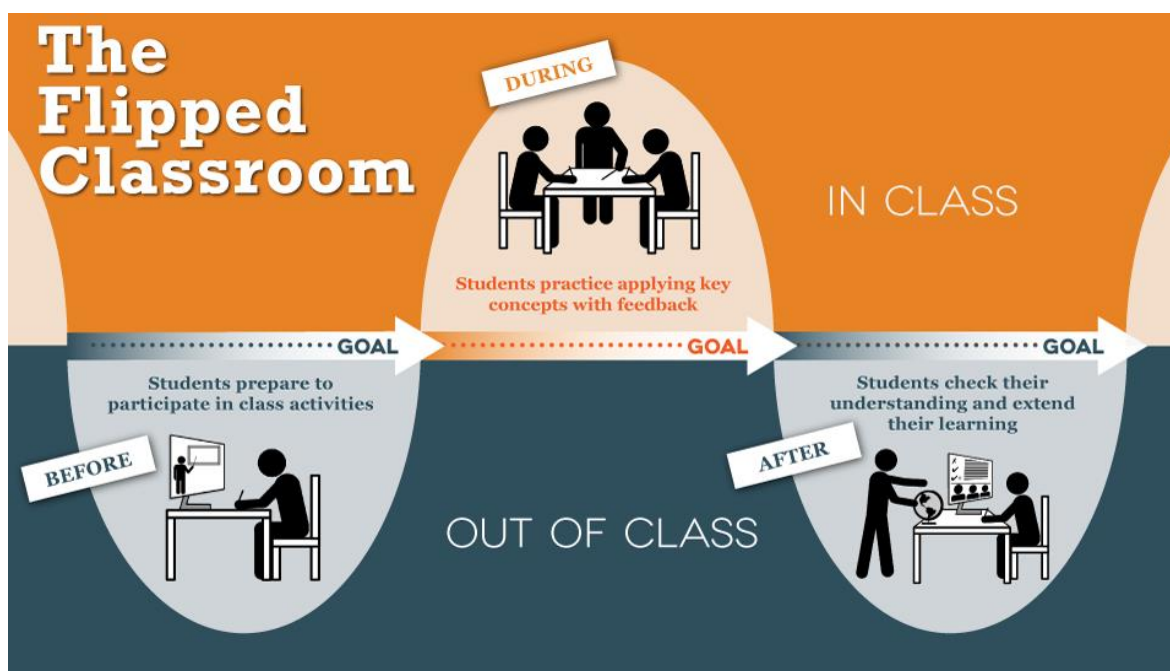


StudentGo for AHS Essentials

(The Flipped Class)



How can AHS Essentials provide students with so much in a half-day schedule? The offering hinges on the use of the “flipped course.” In its most simple terms, a flipped course allows a student to review teaching and lecture content at home, while reserving reduced classroom time for active-learning projects, labs, celebrations, student-sharing and discussions. Since students are learning more independently in a flipped class, we have coined these as StudentGO courses. Importantly, one of the greatest outcomes of the StudentGO course is the age-appropriate development of self-learning skills.

AHS Essentials includes a focused approach on the fundamental academics (math and language arts; also science in middle and high school), while still including a blend of StudentGo classes unique to an AHS education that develop faith, character, and patriotism (daily devotional, history, literature, science, geography, and so on).

Each StudentGo course begins with the recording of a Master teacher. This video lecture is further enhanced with interactive assessments and interactives. Video lessons are visually engaging, simple, and appropriately designed for all ages. Parents are automatically notified via text and email when students complete each video lesson.
